



Directions to SEE

Newfrith House, 21 Hyde Street, Winchester, Hampshire, SO23 7DR

Car Parking

There is very limited parking at the office and public car parks must be used unless a specific arrangement has been made in advance to park at Newfrith House. The public car parks are marked with a 'P' on the map. The Worthy Lane car park is the nearest.

In the event that Worthy Lane car park is full there is an adjacent car park on Worthy Lane situated to the front of the Moat House Hotel. There are other car parks in the City Centre - please follow the signs.

From Worthy Lane – go down with Hyde Close or Hyde Church Lane – turn right onto Hyde Street

SEE is on the right hand side of the road opposite Davis. The car park /bus stop on Worthy Lane are 2-3 minutes walk from the office.

By road: from the North on the A34

Take the Winchester exit (B3420) shortly after the Sutton Scotney Service Station. Proceed South on the B3420 into Winchester and take a left hand turn into Worthy Lane. The Worthy Lane car park is on your left, there is a further car park adjacent to the Worthy Lane car park which is in front

of the Moat House Hotel.

By road: from the North via the M3 and A33

Leave the M3 at Junction 7 and follow the signs on the roundabout for the A30 Basingstoke. Within 100 yards of the roundabout, turn left onto the old A33, following the signs for Kings Worthy.

Follow

this road for 10 miles, to Kings Worthy and then turn right, signposted Winchester, into Worthy Lane. Follow this road for a further 2 miles, into the City where you will find two car parks on your right hand side, just after Hyde Street on the left.

By road: from the South on the M3

Leave the M3 at Junction 11. At the first roundabout, continue ahead. At the second roundabout, turn right into St. Cross Road (B3335) and follow the road all the way into the city centre. At the traffic lights at the T junction, turn right into Jewry Street. As you approach the traffic lights at the junction with City Road remain in the right hand lane but go straight through the traffic lights into Hyde Street. Continue to the end of Hyde Street and turn left into Worthy Lane where you will find two car parks on your right hand side.

Park and Ride

If you wish to use the Park and Ride scheme, leave the M3 at junction 10 and follow signs for the Park and Ride. Board the bus and get off outside the Benefits Agency in City Road. Walk along to the cross roads (Jewry Street, Hyde Street, City Road and North Walls cross roads) and turn left into Hyde Street – SEE is on the left hand side of the road opposite Davis.

By rail

The Railway Station is about a 5 minute walk from the office. Come out of the main entrance and walk down to the large crossroads. Cross over and head down Swan Lane (almost opposite) onto Hyde Street and turn left – SEE is on the left hand side of the road opposite Davis.
